It was back to the Old circuit for the fourth round of the N.C.R.A. H'cap Road Race Series. The longmarker groups kept away this week, with Martin Hamilton taking the honours by 12secs from a chasing group of 13, which contained Stuart Walters in 12<sup>th</sup> position. Andy Fairley came in with a small group in equal 26<sup>th</sup> place.

Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> March.

Quite a cool morning, with the usual battle past Harrington Airfield, in the Club 20.8ml T.T. taking in the Lamport 10ml course and the Old circuit. Rob Barker was a clear winner in 52.38, with the improving Darren Botterill 2<sup>nd</sup> in 56.49, and Josh Monger, making a good start to the season, 3<sup>rd</sup> in 58.07, a 3 minute P.B. #### Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> April

Horrible night for the first Club Evening T.T. of 11.7mls on the Grafton Underwood circuit. It was cold and wet, although the rain eased enough for the 11 brave souls who opted to ride. Darren Botterill's win was well worth another photo in the E.T. His time of 33.07, was just 33 seconds too good for second placed Robin Bellamy, with Club Secretary Adrian Tilley third in 34.24. In the event at North Cave, Humberside, for machines with no aerodynamic aids, Gavin recorded 23.43, behind winner, and last years champion, Ian Cammish, PlanetX, 22.33.

#### Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> April

Confusion aplenty in the V.T.T.A. Echelon Cycles 10ml T.T. at Princethorpe. With the course in doubt until the day due to road works, it was eventually declared O.K. only to have an accident on the A45 part of the course, closing the road. A hastily revised course was found, resulting in a 8.5ml Circuit. Tom Bailey, 26.03, and Bernard Smith, 27.16, both got thoroughly soaked as the heavens opened halfway through the event. Winner was Matt Clinton, Mike Vaughn Cycles, in a super-fast 17.58.

#### Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> April

Andy Fairley, 17<sup>th</sup>, and Stu Walters, 38<sup>th</sup>, continued their N.C.R.A. H'cap R.R. campaign in the 5<sup>th</sup> round at Southwick. Long-marker, Martyn Brown, Welland Valley C.C. led from the start and was never caught, although he was only 9secs clear at the end.

#### Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> April

The sunshine brought them out this week in the second Club 11.7ml C.T.T. at Grafton Underwood, doubling the previous weeks field. Junior Sam Brogan of the Leicestershire R.C. took the sprint finish. Robin Bellamy was in the charge for the line in equal ninth, with the same time as the winner. Stuart Walters, who has had a good series, was just 21secs. down in 41<sup>st</sup> place, with Paul Ashdown 53<sup>rd</sup>. Overall winner was Matt Garfield of the Fenland Clarion.

### Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> April

Despite a cold, windy evening, 24 riders contested the 3<sup>rd</sup> Club 11.7ml C.T.T. at Grafton Underwood. Rob Barker was a clear winner in 29.01, 16secs better than the previous week, with Gavin Hinxman, back after his enforced lay-off, second in 30.51. David Robinson moved up 22secs. to take 3<sup>rd</sup> place in 31.49. Darren Botterill took 13secs of last weeks time with 32.02, just pipping Tony Brown, 32.05, making his first appearance of the year.
