## Racing Results

Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> April

In the Welland Valley C.C. 10ml T.T. on the Kibworth-Market Harborough course, Rob Barker finished well up with his time of 22.43, and Club Webmaster Shaun Bailey recorded 26.08. Winner, by just one second was James Perkins, of Zenith C.C. in 20.53.

Paul Ashdown and Mark Booth, tied with a time of 24.48 in the St. Ives C.C. 10ml T.T. at Sawtry. Bernard Smith, 29.04 and Tom Bailey, 29.30, made up the K.C.C. contingent. Mick Hodson, St. Ives C.C. scored a fine double, winning the open event in 22.13, and the preceding 72inch gear event in 24.22.

Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> April

It was a fourth successive win for Rob Barker in tonight's round of the 11.7ml C.T.T's at Grafton Underwood.
