Racing Report

Saturday 19th June

Just two Club riders competed in the N.& D.C.A. 10ml T.T. on the rural course around Woodnewton and Nassington. Mike O'Connor, 29.15, and Mick Wood, 31.19, found there way round the lanes, as Dominic Sweeney, Lutterworth C.C. won in 23.12.

Tuesday 22nd June

In the 4th round of the N.C.R.A. H'cap Road Race on the Naseby circuit, the field all came together on the final lap. In the dash for the finish, Stuart Walters was well up, finishing in equal 10th spot, his best placing of the series. Winner was James Cambridge, I-Ride.

Tuesday 29th June

Stuart Walters continued his N.C.R.A. campaign in the fifth round of the series at Southwick. Stu was off the 32man bunch racing for the honours, finishing 46th, with previous week's winner James Cambridge taking top spot.

Wednesday 30th June

Three smiling faces after good conditions in the 45RC Club 10 on the N7/10 prompted a glut of good times. Gavin Hinxman, 21.48. Mark Booth, 22.26. and Paul Ashdown, 22.34, all benefited from the nice evening.

Thursday 1st July

Lady member, Natalie Sharpe has generously allowed us to park in her field on the outskirts of Old, a great asset. The first of two Club 18.8ml C.T.T's, over two circuits At Old was held in very windy conditions, which failed to drop, as second lap times were slower. Sunday 4th July

The N18/10 Broughton course had one of its better days for this mornings Club 10ml T.T. Bob Hill and Gavin Hinxman did the timing, and Mike O'Connor marshalled the Sywell roundabout. Rob Barker took the honours in 22.55. followed by Paul Ashdown, 24.38. and David Robinson, improving by 16secs. for a P.B. of 24.44. Other times were:- Stu Jones, 25.38. Tom Bailey, 28.44. Andy Laing, 29.00. Mick Wood, 29.30. Bernard Smith, 29.44.

Wednesday 7th July

Club Coach, Robin Bellamy had a good outing in the final round of the N.C.R.A. Handicap R.R. Series at Southwick. Robin finished in 14th place, as winner, James Cambridge, I-Ride, scored his third win in a row. Stuart Walters ended a successful series, finishing in the group of 19th equal.

Thursday 8th July

A much better night for the second Club 18.8ml C.T.T., very warm, with much lighter winds. All that rode the first event improved. Rapidly improving Stu Jones took advantage of the non-appearance of series leader Rob Barker, to secure his first Club win, in 47.38. Robin Bellamy was just 11secs. in arrears in second place. Marshalls were, Josh Monger, Robert Draycott and Alasdair Shed of the 45RC.

Saturday 10th July

It was an early start for riders in the Beds. Road C.C. 10ml T.T. on the flat F1 course at Tempsford, although the rising wind spoilt what could have been a good morning. Club 10ml Record Holder, Gavin Hinxman, put in a fine 4th placed ride of 21.56. Behind winner, Sam Barker, Planet X, who seemed pleased with his 20.38. Bernard Smith also rode, clocking a 27.54.

Paul Ashdown clocked a fine 59.38, in the Plan B Racing event at Etwall. This was a half a minute beating of his previous best at the distance.

The three N.& D.C.A. regulars from the K.C.C., Mike O'Connor, Mick Wood, and Tom Bailey, all competed in the Associations 15mile T.T. on the Stilton course, in very hot, and draining conditions. Mike clocked 44.24. Mick, 45.55, and Tom, 46.13. Winner was Peter Galpin, St. Ives C.C. in 34.13.

Sunday 11th July

Rob Barker duly retained his Club 25ml Championship, with a fine seasons best of 56.47, on the N7/25 course at Earls Barton. Tony Brown clocked a recent best of 1.0.42, to be runner-up, whilst Stu Jones tackled the 25ml distance for the first time, taking third place in 1.2.44. Andy Laing made an improvement of 1.20, for a P.B. of 1.15.09. Gavin Hinxman went through the 25ml point in 58.52, and continued to complete the 30mile course in a fine 1.10.40, to establish a new K.C.C. Record for the distance. The course was well signed by Michael Church of the 45RC, and Bob Hill was timekeeper. Other times:- Robin Bellamy, 1.3.20. Michael Rogers, 1.6.23. David Robinson, 1.6.50. Mick Wood, 1.14.43. Thursday 15th July

Robert White had a slippery ride in the Friday Night M.T.B. event at Avalanche Adventure course. Heavy rain made the surface treacherous, as Robert slid to 26th place in the Veterans race.

Saturday 17th July

Two cracking rides from the Clubs top time-triallists in the A.P.I. 25 on the fast E2/25 at Newmarket. Rob Barker returns to top form with a 54.59. and Gavin Hinxman clocked 56.08.

Mark Booth turned in another sub-hour ride with a 59.43, in the North Notts Olympic 25, on the A1 at Carlton on Trent. Winner was Matt Bottrill, I-Ride, in 49.51.

Wednesday 21st July

Gavin Hinxman rode a fine 10ml ride of 21.56, for 8th place in the V.T.T.A. event on the Leighton Buzzard by-pass. Warm, with just a light wind felt on the exposed sections. Bernard Smith, just for once, edged in front of Tom Bailey, with his 27.54, to Toms 28.05. Winner was Jason Gurney, Team M.K. in 20.05.

Thursday 22nd July

Earlier rain must have deterred riders as only 15 contested the Club 9.4ml C.T.T. at Old. But rain cleared leaving a fine evening, with only a light wind. Tony Brown and Bob Hill were timekeepers. Tom Bailey and Bernard Smith marshalled. Darren Botterill made a 1.20 step forward to a best of 23.49. Norbert Radvanszki had his first ride for the K.C.C. with a 26.30. Harvey Childs tried out his new mean machine with a 25.53. John Tilley won the battle of the longmarkers with George Bridge by 12secs. 34.25 to 34.37. Times:- Rob Barker, 22.13. Paul Ashdown, 23.20. Not quite the conditions hoped for in the Verulam 25, with an early start on the F1 at Tempsford. The cross-wind was most unhelpful. Rob Barker kept up his run of fine rides with a 55.45, for 8th place. Whilst brother Sam, Planet X, won by 40secs. in 52.08. Bernard Smith went through the motions of racing with a 1.13.11.

Tom Bailey, with a time of 1.12.08, gave him a plus of 11.36, to be 4th Vet. On Standard, in the Leicester Forest C.C. 25 on the Six Hills course North of Leicester. Winner was Geoff Platts, I-Ride, in 55.02, in a breezy cross wind.
