Third overall was David Robinson, who tied for third place on the night with Mark Booth, both on 23.36. Mark Affuso timed and Bob Hill assisted the 27 riders. Chris Pettis marshalled. After a good season of road racing performances, Stuart Walters got his reward with a bronze medal performance in the 70+ LVRC Criterium Championship at Darley Moor. After the hour long race, Stuart was just behind first placed Ken Haddon, Bush Healthcare, and Derrick Woodings, Team Endura.

Gavin Hinxman's effort at promoting the Club Open 10, the Frank and Joy Sheppard Memorial, were rewarded with a fine entry of 69 riders, plus fine weather. The large field included 16 K.C.C. riders. Overall winner of the open section was Matt Sinclair, Leics. R.C. well clear in 21.53. Rob Barker was 6th in 23.33. other Club times:- Tony Brown, 24.16. Darren Botterill, 26.05. Shaun Bailey, 27.30. Mick Wood, 29.45. Tom Bailey, 30.16. Wayne Hodson, after a ten year lay-off, was winner of the M.T.B. section with his fine 28.58. In the Old Skool section for non-aero machines, Gavin Hinxman took second award in 26.10. with Clive Hewson 3rd in 27.15. Other Club riders:- Phil Nudds, 27.34. Mike O'Connor, 28.07. Natalie Sharp, 31.20. Pete Etheridge, 32.26. Bernard Smith, 33.06. Two novice riders performed well in their first time trials, Andy Read did 31.37 and John Hutchins, 34.12.

Rob Barker retained his Hill Climb Championship title with two impressive climbs of Neville Holt. Robin Bellamy was second, and Darren Botterill was third. Bernard Smith and Tom Bailey were timekeepers, assisted by Max Scott and Colin Pountney.

The early start for the Icknield Charity 10 at Tempsford looked promising, but it didn't quite live up to expectations. The cross wind offered little help in either direction. Two Club members rode; Paul Ashdown clocked 23.39, and Bernard Smith, 28.32. Sam Barker, Planet X, won by 17secs. in 20.43.

Disappointing conditions too, for the Port Talbot Whs. Welsh Championship 25, at Neath, South Wales. Club T.T. Sec. Gavin Hinxman did a 55.15.

Saturday 18th Sept

Great end of season 10mile rides from three of the Clubs time triallists in the C.D.L.C.A. over-subscribed event on the A1 at Long Bennington. Tony Brown sliced a minute off his best time with a fine 22.03. Paul Ashdown also improved, 28secs. better in 22.06. Mark Booth was close up with 22.39, to establish what must be a K.C.C. 10ml Team Record. There was a fair cross-wind, the rising nature of the return leg, made it a harder finish. Down as a reserve, Bernard Smith got a ride, and clocked a seasons best of 27.17. There was no disputing the winner, Michael Hutchinson, In-Gear Quickvit, was in a class of his own with 18.42.

Gavin Hinxman was not so lucky with the conditions in the Wigan Whs. 10ml at Levens in Cumbria. High winds and rain made for miserable conditions. Gavin's 21.46, was half a minute down on his seasons best.

Sunday 26th Sept

It was a tough day for the final event of the N.& D.C.A. Time Trial Series, a 22.6ml out and home on the Shefford by-pass, starting at Cardington. The cold North wind made it most unpleasant, particularly the return leg. Runs Leader, Tom Bailey was the only Club entrant, and was way off his course best with 1.11.21. Jason Gurney, of Team M.K. was the winner in 51.36.
