Racing Report

Saturday 2nd April

Stuart Walters was a puncture victim in round 5 of the N.C.R.A. Road Race Series at Southwick. Stuart was well placed in a leading group of four on the final lap, only to be thwarted in the final stages. John Hardwick continued his good showing in the series with a 15th place, and David Robinson 20th, both credited with the same time as the winner, David Palmer, Renault Rotor Colbert R.T.

It was a good time-trialling afternoon on the K10/10 Princethorpe course for the V.T.T.A. 10 mile which attracted 137 entries. Gavin Hinxman had a fine ride of 22.24, but with only old-timers for support, Tom Bailey in 28.05, and Bernard Smith, 28.55. no chance of a team prize. All seemed pleased with their times. Richard Bradley, I-Ride, winning in 20.00. exactly 30.m.p.h.

Thursday 7th April

The K.C.C. Evening Series of Club T.T's kicked off with an 11.7ml circuit at Grafton Underwood. The 18 riders were dispatched by timekeeper Shaun Bailey, pushed off by George Bridge, with Marshalling by Keith Barwell. Tony Brown took the honours in 30.50, 39secs. ahead of David Robinson, with John Hardwick 3rd in 32.00. Other times:- Josh Monger, 32.43. Jon Thorne, 33.58. Huw Marchbank, 35.29. Marcus Buksh, 35.37. Tom Bailey, 37.55. Mick Wood, 39.30. Bernard Smith, 43.00. John Tilley, 47.18.

Saturday 9th April

A pile-up in the 30-man sprint for the line marred the final round of the N.C.R.A. H'cap R.R. Series. John Hardwick avoided the collision to take a fine 4th place in his road racing debut series. David Robinson was also in the mix, taking 10th place, in another good series. Stuart Walters was there as well credited with 25th place in the same time as the winner, Joe Clarke of the Fenland Clarion C.C.

Thursday 14th April

Tony Brown carried on where he left off last week, winning with exactly the same time of 30.50. Ironman aspirants Adrian Tilley, 31.55, and Chris Brennan, 32.06. took 2nd and 3rd places. John Tilley showed his bionic knee is working well, improving 2mins. to 45.48. David Robinson recorded the following times:- Tim Hartley, 32.30. Josh Monger, 33.17. Jon Thorne, 34.12. Huw Marchbank, 34.33. Andrew Jones, 35.29. Tom Bailey, 37.52. Mick Wood, 38.15. Bernard Smith, 41.20. Pat and Dot Houghton marshalled the crossroads.

Saturday 16th April

Good conditions for the N.& D.C.A. 20ml C.T.T. over two laps of the Bringhurst-Ashley circuit, resulted in a new course record of 44.33 and a tie for 1st place between Scott Walker, I-Ride, and Jason Gurney, Baines Racing. Gavin Hinxman finished well up the finishing order with his 48.37. Robin Bellamy clocked 54.03, with veterans Mick Wood, 1.3.13, Bernard Smith, 1.8.08. and Pete Etheridge, 1.10.10, who unfortunately took a tumble at the end of the first lap.

Sunday 17th April

Mark Booth recorded a fine 1.01.01 in the Beds Road C.C. 25ml T.T. on the F1 at Tempsford. Winner was Nick Hutchins, CS Grupetto, in 50.41.

As usual it felt like a good morning for the Club 10 at Broughton, and as usual it was quite a struggle on the longer return leg. A good turn out of 19 riders were timed by Phil Nudds, pushed off by Graham Boniface, with Ken Vatcher marshalling the turn.

Gavin Hinxman signed the course, and then rode to a winning 23.39, 48secs. ahead of Stu Jones, with Darren Botterill a close third in 24.42. Paul Ashdown and David Robinson tied for fourth spot with 25.07. Other times were:- Shaun Bailey, 25.50. Tim Hartley, 26.31. Martin Smith, 28.29. Andrew Jones, 28.12. Phil England, 28.51. Mick Wood, 30.26. Bernard Smith, 31.05. John Tilley, 35.18.

Robert White came 159th in a field of nearly 500 in his first Duston Triathlon. He needs to learn to count to sixteen after swimming two lengths (50 metres) too many. The event comprised a 400 metre pool swim followed by a 20K hilly time trial taking in Great and Little Broughton and finishing with a 4.8k run..

Thursday 21st April

The best evening of the series so far in the Club 11.7 circuit events at Grafton Underwood produced a glut of P.B.'s. Tony Brown improved 29secs. to complete his hat-trick of wins in 30.21. This follows a 3min. P.B. by Tony in the Duston Triathlon. David Robinson moved up 48secs. for a second placed 30.41. Third place went to Eddie Clutton in 31.23. Other times:- Darren Botterill, just off his best with 32.04, Stu Jones, 32.10. Tim Hartley, 32.23,(P.B. 7secs.). Josh Monger, 32.35,(P.B. 42secs.). Huw Marchbank,34.12,(P.B. 21secs.). Bernard Smith, 40.22. John Tilley, 47.50. Joel Lewis unfortunately strayed off course and was D.N.F. Shaun Bailey held the watch, Phil Quincey pushed off, and Mick Wood marshalled.

Saturday 23rd April

Fine sunny and warm conditions for the St. Ives 10ml T.T. on the N1/10 course at Sawtry. Sky Prop Cycling star Alex Dowsett was a runaway winner with a new course record of 19.24. Taking 23secs off Michael Hutchinson's four year old time.

Alex promptly donated his substantial winnings to the club and charity. Three K.C.C. members rode, Paul Ashdown seemed satisfied with his 24.24. Tom Bailey, after a week of illness, did well to clock 29.12, and Bernard Smith failed to beat evens with 30.05.
